The SETT Framework is a guideline used by a team for gathering data in order to make effective assistive technology decisions. The SETT Framework considers first, the STUDENT, the ENVIRONMENT(S) and the TASKS required for active participation in the activities of the environment, and finally, the system of TOOLS needed for the student to address the tasks.

2. What motivates this student?

3. What are their current special education needs/services?

4. What is their learning style?



5. What does the student need to do, but are currently unable to do?

6. What behaviors both positive and negative affect the student's ability to complete tasks?

8. What are the student's long-range goals?

9. Any other issues the team should be aware of?
