There was a motion by Holdingford, seconded by Rocori to approve the MREA Annual Membership for 2018-2019, annual fee is \$916.67. The motion was unanimously approved.

There was a motion by Foley, seconded by Holdingford to approve a transfer from the General Fund to the Food Service Fund to cover the deficit of \$5,746.25 for the 2017-2018 school year. The motion was unanimously approved.

The Negotiation Committee came to a tentative agreement on August 7th with the Licensed Staff for the 2017-2019 Contract. Total package is 7.26% which includes increases in salary matrix for 17-18 of 2.70% and 2.61% for 18-19, \$250 increase in Single and \$500 in Family Health Insurance Employer contributions for 18-19. Union will vote the week of August 27<sup>th</sup> and if approved will come to board in September for approval.

There was a discussion on the 2018-2019 SCTCC Contract for leased space for the 18-21 program. The monthly lease cost is estimated to be \$2,869.18 per month. There are still a few items that need to be clarified in the lease. Approval of the lease is tabled until the September board meeting.

A Public Hearing Notice was received from the City of Sauk Rapids. The city is holding a meeting on August 27<sup>th</sup> to discuss proposed property improvements near our Voyagers building which would result in property assessments. More information will be shared after the August 27th meeting.
